Ages 3-8

- 1.) **What is the Holy Trinity?** The Holy Trinity is the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit- one God in three Divine Persons. This is who we recognize when we make the sign of the cross! The Father is God, the son is Jesus, and the Holy Spirit. **Who is the Holy Spirit?** The Holy Spirit is also God and the Third Person of the Trinity. God and his son, Jesus, sent the Holy Spirit to his people fifty days after Jesus rose from the dead. We call this special day Pentecost Sunday. It is the day that God gave us His Spirit here on earth! Do you remember who the Holy Trinity is?
- 2.) **Do you know where in the Bible we can find stories about Jesus?** They are found in the book of the Gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke and John) within the New Testament. We read stories about Jesus every time we go to Mass! What are the Gospels about? Do we read the Gospel every time we go to mass?
- 3.) **What does it mean to be a Christian?** It means that we are followers of Jesus Christ and we belong to His Church. Jesus became man and died for our sins so that you and I may have life. Jesus established His Church on earth so that we may lead others to Him and eventually spend eternity (forever!) in His Kingdom, Heaven. Are you a Christian? What part of being a Christian do you like the most?
- 4.) **Who are the Saints?** Saints were everyday people like you and I who did an extraordinary job of loving God and His people and as a result, became more and more like Him. There are so many incredible saints to learn about. We can pray to these saints and just like we ask our friends and family to pray for us, we can ask them to pray for us too! Can you name any of the Saints? What Makes a Saint different from other people? Do you want to be a saint? Why?
- 5.) **We know that God loves when we pray to Him! What are some other things we can do to make Him happy?** God loves when we are reverent in Mass, obedient to our parents and follow their rules, kind to our siblings and share our toys, grateful for the meals our parents make us, and honest in telling the truth (even when it's super hard!) These good habits are called virtues and they will help us to become more like Jesus! What do Virtues mean? What are some ways that you are virtuous?
