The Enthronement to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is a beautiful Catholic devotion where a family places an image or statue of the Sacred Heart in a special place in the home to publicly honor Jesus as the King, Friend, and Head of the household. Families usually gather together to pray, read Scripture, bless the image, and consecrate their home and hearts to Jesus. This can be done at any time of the year, but many families choose the Feast of the Sacred Heart, First Fridays, or another meaningful family celebration day. The enthronement is not just a one-time ceremony, but a commitment to live with Christ at the center of family life through prayer, love, forgiveness, and faithfulness each day.
